- 3. The IEP Snapshot Report can be filtered by Resident County/School, Service County/School and/or Grade.

Tip: Notice that the resident county/school fields no longer default to your resident county/school. The search will only yield results for resident and service schools to which the user is assigned.

4. Once criteria and Data Elements have been selected, click **Show Students** to view the names of the students that meet the selected criteria.

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Note: If the service county and school, as well as, the Resident County and school criteria are selected, the reporting tool will yield a smaller, more specific set of results. Selecting the resident county will produce a report of students within the selected county regardless of Service County. Selecting the service county will produce a report of students within the selected county regardless of Resident County.

- 5. Choose which student or students will be included in the IEP Snapshot report by clicking on the square check box next to the desired student's name.
- 6. Or to choose all students, click the Select All button.
- 7. Next, click the **Run Report** button.
